

Vital Death Records: Deceased 1971 to present and Death occurred in Henry County

Illinois Law states that access to Death records is restricted to the following people:

- *Person having personal or property right interest with the decedent
- *If not a relative of the deceased, a letter or document from the office or agency that needs the death certificate must accompany the request
- *An uncertified copy of death record is available to genealogical researchers if the death occurred at least 20 years prior to the date of the request

Cost for certified record is \$11 for the first copy and \$6 for each additional copy. Cost for genealogical uncertified record is \$5. Death records can be paid for with credit card, cash, money order, cashiers check, or personal check made out to the Henry County Health Department.
